Blake Jorgenson works and lives as a professional outdoor adventure and mountain sport photographer. As a senior photographer for Powder, Freeskier, and Skier magazines, he has shot magazine editorials and assignments around the world and has an impressive list of advertising clients including; United airlines, Bell mobility, Helly Hansen, Adidas, Oakley, Salomon, Rossignol, Head, and others.

In 2001 he became the only entrant to win both the pro Photographer Search and the Pro Photographer Showdown contests at the World ski and Snowboard festival in the same year. In 2002 he took best of show at the South American Photo challenge in Portillo, Chile and in 2003 he was awarded Photo of the year honour from Powder Magazine.

Originally from Hamilton, Ontario, Blake headed west at the age of 17 and scraped his way up earning the respect of both his subjects and the local photographic community.

He is known for his striking images that intuitively capture the essence of local mountain terrain and his ability to keep up with the hardcore set that can ride it.

Kurtis Croy
